Background of the COVID-19 Relief Project

The proposal to provide relief material to people affected by COVID-19 surrounding 8 villages of Kiran Grameen Coaching Center in the District of Varanasi; Uttar Pradesh, India emerged as a response to Covid-19 2nd wave posing great challenges both to public health as well as livelihood crisis. In a worrying development, India had reported a single-day highest spike of 4,14,188 new Covid-19 cases on 6th May 2021and highest deaths approximately 4,529 on 18th May 2021.

The sudden overall impact of the second wave of COVID-19 was very much visible. On the economic front within few days GDP growth was negatively affected, as a result people at the rural areas, especially, "Below Poverty Line" population (BPL), Middle Class and nomad people (Mushar, Nats and Schedule Tribe and Schedule Tribe), etc. were out of work completely.

The situation in Varanasi was also very horrifying and people in the districts were left in the lurch by virus and lockdown. The government's measures or the lack thereof, failed to ease burden of the people, especially in the rural areas of Harahua, Pindra and Baragaon Development Blocks. Rural communities, young, elderly populations and individuals with disabilities and chronic health conditions were the worst hit by Covid-19.

Thus in this difficult times, Jan Vikas Samiti as a responsible organization took up the cognizance of the situation and approached FIDEI with a small proposal to reach out with relief material to the people affected by covide-19 surrounding 8 villages of Kiran Grameen Center in the District of Varanasi, Uttar Pradesh India with following intervention relief items on the urgent basis;

Intervention Relief Items

- Distribution of ration kits, medicine kits, immune booster and masks to the 86 Coaching Center children.
- Distribution of dry ration, medicine kits and masks to the 45 tailoring girls of the Coaching Center.
- Distribution of dry ration, medicine kits and masks to the 10 bakery unity men.
- Distribution of ration kits, medicine kits, immune booster and masks 111 children with disabilities surrounding Kiran Grameen Coaching Center.
- Distribution of ration kits to the 741 Mushar families surrounding Kiran Grameen Coaching Center.
- COVID-19 awareness reaching 5000 people through handbills distribution.

Relief Work

Jan Vikas Samiti appointed a team of 12 staff to execute the relief work timely including 4 staff from the Kiran Grameen Center after the approval of the project. JVS procured the essential medicines kits, Immune Booster Kits, Dry Ration Kits, and masks for the distribution and printed handbills to create awareness among the 5000 public about the COVID-19 and prevention measures such as wearing masks, sanitizing hands more often, maintaining distance and most importantly registering on COWIN portal and taking vaccine, etc.

1. We distributed ration kits, medicine kits, immune booster kits and masks to the 86 coaching center children. The list of beneficiaries is annexed.
